# Process for Growing Fresh Produce for Export and the European Market

## KENAYO

### **Selection of Crop and Location**

Select crops suited to your climate and soil conditions.

Prepare land for fertile and has access to water and infrastructure.

### **Sourcing Inputs**

Procure high-quality seeds or saplings from certified suppliers.

Use sustainable and approved fertilizers, pesticides, and organic inputs.

### **Cultivation and Farming Practices**

Follow Good Agricultural Practices (GAP) to ensure quality.

Use proper irrigation, pest control, and disease management techniques.

Implement crop rotation and other sustainable farming practices.

### **Harvesting and Post-Harvest Handling**

Harvest crops at optimal maturity for export quality.

Use proper techniques to avoid bruising and damage.

Clean, sort, and grade produce according to customer requirements.

### **Packaging and Labeling**

Use export-grade packaging to ensure durability during transit.

Label products with traceability information, origin, and certifications.

Consider eco-friendly and biodegradable packaging options.

Available packing are 1.5, 2, 4, 5, 6, 10,12 kg box and 40ft containers.

## **Quality Assurance and Certification**

- Conduct quality checks to meet Export standards.
- Follow necessary process of GlobalGAP, HACCP, and organic certifications.

## **Cold Chain Management**

- Implemented cold storage solutions to preserve freshness.
- Ensure an unbroken cold chain during transportation.

## **Logistics and Shipping**

- Choose reliable logistics partners experienced in exporting.
- Ensure compliance with customs and phytosanitary requirements.
- Use appropriate containers and transport methods.
